Scanner Pre-Installation Checklist

This quick reference guide is designed to provide a checklist to avoid installation problems. It should be reviewed **BEFORE** installation occurs.

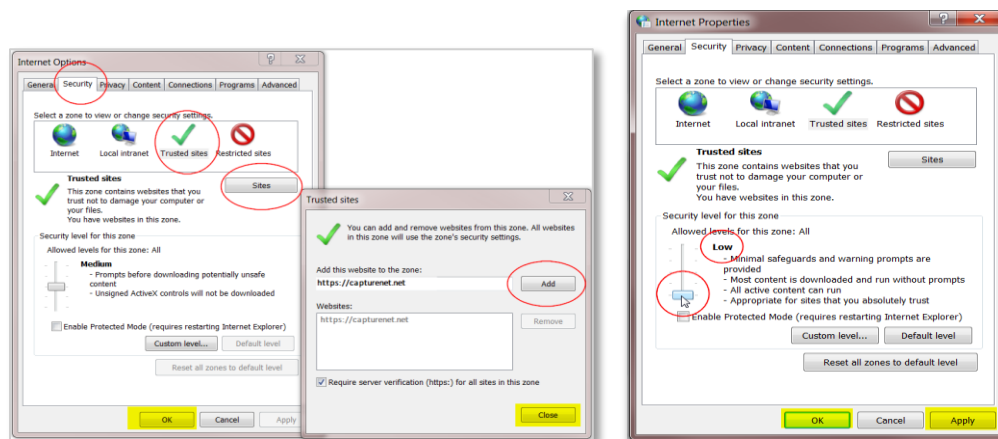
For CaptureNet to work properly, the following installation pre-requisites must be implemented.

Step 1: Local Administrative Rights

At the time of the installation the user must have Local Administrative rights. They are not needed once the application has been successfully deployed.

Step 2: Trusted Site and Trusted Site Security

1. Open *Internet Explorer*.
2. Click on *Tools* and select *Internet Options*.
3. Click on the *Security* tab.
4. Select *Trusted Sites* in the *Select a zone to view or change security settings* option.
5. Click on the *Sites* button.
6. In the *Add this Web site to the zone box*, type: <https://capturenet.net>, and then click *Add*.



7. Click on *Close* and then click *OK* to accept the changes.
8. Next step is to lower the *Trusted Sites* security to *low* as shown above.
9. After you are done, select *Apply* and *Ok* to return to Internet Explorer.

Step 3: Whitelisting

Whitelisting the communications URL is sometimes necessary to allow communication between the scanning workstation and the server. The instructions on how to perform this vary by version of Windows and Security software. But please make sure to whitelist <https://capturenet.net>.
